CABLED MITTENS



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A pair of cosy cabled mittens. Knitted in our either our Grace or Meadow Jacqui Fink collaboration super chunky yarns.

YARN

Grace Super Chunky

70% Recycled Cashmere, 30% Cashmere

240m per 400g cone (263 yards)

Meadow Super Chunky

100% Merino Wool

240m per 400g cone (263 yards)

Requires 90g's (of either Grace or Meadow)

TOOLS

10mm Double pointed needles

Cable needle

Stitch markers

Large-eyed blunt tip sewing needle

TENSION 10 X 10 CM

Measure over the stitches using 10mm needles

1x1 rib: 10 sts and 14 rows

Stocking stitch: 10 sts and 13 rows

Please test your tension before starting this project!

SIZING

Length	21cm
Circumference (at widest)	20cm
Circumference (at cuff)	18cm

NOTES

Worked in the round beginning with 1x1 ribbing before going into cabling pattern repeat. There is slight increasing towards the palm and then decreasing towards the end of the mittens. The thumb section is picked up and worked separately to complete.

MAKE - Left hand

Using 10mm needles cast on 18 sts. PM. Join to work in the rnd.

Rnd 1 - 6: (RS) * K1, P1 * rep * across all sts. SM

Rnd 7 - 10: P2, K8, P8, SM.

Rnd 11: P2, C4B, C4F, P8, SM.

Rnd 12-13: Rep rnd 7.

Begin thumb increasing

Rnd 14: P2, K8, P4, M1P, P1, M1P, P3, SM. (20 sts)

Rnd 15: P2, K8, P3, M1P, P7, SM. (21 sts)

Rnd 16: P2, K8, P6, M1P, P2, M1P, P3, SM. (23 sts)

Thumb opening section

Rnd 17: P2, K8, P9, BO3, P1, SM. (20 sts)

Rnd 18: P2, K8, P9, CO3, P1, SM. (23 sts)

Palm decrease section

Rnd 19: P2, C4B, C4F, P4, P2tog, P1, P2tog, P4, SM. (21 sts)

Rnd 20: P2, K8, P5, P2tog, P4, SM. (20 sts)

Rnd 21: P2, K8, P5, P2tog, P3, SM. (19 sts)

Rnd 22: P2, K8, P5, P2tog, P2 SM. (18 sts)

Rnd 23: P2, K8, P3, P2tog, P1, P2tog, SM. (16 sts)

Rnd 24: P2, K8, P6, SM. (16 sts)

End ribbing

Rnd 25-27: * K1, P1 * rep * across all sts. RM on last rnd.

BO all sts.

Thumb pick up

Pick up 8 sts around thumb hole.

P all sts for 2 rnds.

BO all sts.

FINISH

Weave in loose ends then gently steam.

MAKE – Right hand

Using 10mm needles cast on 18 sts. PM. Join to work in the rnd.

Rnd 1 - 6: (RS) * K1, P1 * rep * across all sts. SM

Rnd 7 - 10: P8, K8, P2, SM.

Rnd 11: P8, C4B, C4F, P2, SM.

Rnd 12-13: Rep rnd 7.

Begin thumb increasing

Rnd 14: P3, M1P, P1, M1P, P4, K8, P2, SM. (20 sts)

Rnd 15: P7, M1P, P3, K8, P2, SM. (21 sts)

Rnd 16: P3, M1P, P2, M1P, P6, K8, P2, SM. (23 sts)

Thumb opening section

Rnd 17: P1, BO3, P9, K8, P2, SM. (20 sts)

Rnd 18: P1, CO3, P9, K8, P2, SM. (23 sts)

Palm decrease section

Rnd 19: P4, P2tog, P1, P2tog, P4, C4B, C4F, P2, SM. (21 sts)

Rnd 20: P4, P2tog, P5, K8, P2, SM. (20 sts)

Rnd 21: P3, P2tog, P5, K8, P2, SM. (19 sts)

Rnd 22: P2, P2tog, P5, K8, P2, SM. (18 sts)

Rnd 23: P2tog, P1, P2tog, P3, K8, P2, SM. (16 sts)

Rnd 24: P6, K8, P2, SM. (16 sts)

Repeat remaining stages from *** from the left hand mitten's instructions to 'Finish'.
